Mortar Drain is a porous filter designed to protect the weep holes located in the clamping ring collar of the floor drain. The filter keeps the weep holes and collar surface clear of mortar. The porosity of the filter keeps the weep holes and collar surface clear of mortar while allowing rapid water flow through.



Model UNIV 1 (Universal Model) Fits most shower drains

- a. Bolt hole "A" is used with all drains.
- b. For drains with 4 bolts, remove A and B holes.
- c. For drain with 3 bolts remove A and C holes.
- d. For drains with larger diameter necks, tear out the inner radius (circle).



- Installs over weep holes on shower drain
- Porosity promotes flow to weep holes
- Protects weep holes from mortar clog

**Installation Instructions**: Lay the Mortar Drain filter over the "TOP" of the floor drain clamping ring collar. (ON THE TOP OF THE WEEP HOLES). The filter should lay flat over the clamping ring, fitting around any bolt heads that might be located on the top of the collar.

WARNING: Do not install filter underneath clamping ring, this will cause the shower to leak.

Follow all recommended procedures for placement of a shower floor mortar bed in the Tile Council of America handbook and Uniform Plumbing Code Standard IS-4. Mortar installer should be experienced in installation of mortar beds, drains, and shower floors. A minimum of one and one-half inches of compacted reinforced mortar should be placed over the Mortar Drain. Failure to follow these procedures could result in an ineffective installation or weak mortar bed. NOTE: Because the installation of the mortar bed and floor is beyond our control, we will not be responsible for results obtained.

The Uniform plumbing Code label UPC is a registered trademark of the International Association of Plumbing and Mechanical Officials, (IAPMO). Mortar Drain has been tested to exceed the IAPMO requirements for "Porous Filter Protection for Sub-Drain weep holes" and is a listed product with IAPMO.
